As an organisation we recognise that reducing our Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions brings significant benefits for us, our customers, suppliers and the wider community. This Carbon Reduction Plan (CRP) will cover OPP's baseline year information (2024-2025), setting clear targets for reducing GHG emissions over key timeframes and planned actions to achieve Carbon Net Zero by 2050 at the latest. Our aim is to ensure the highest levels of engagement with this Carbon Reduction Plan across OPP.

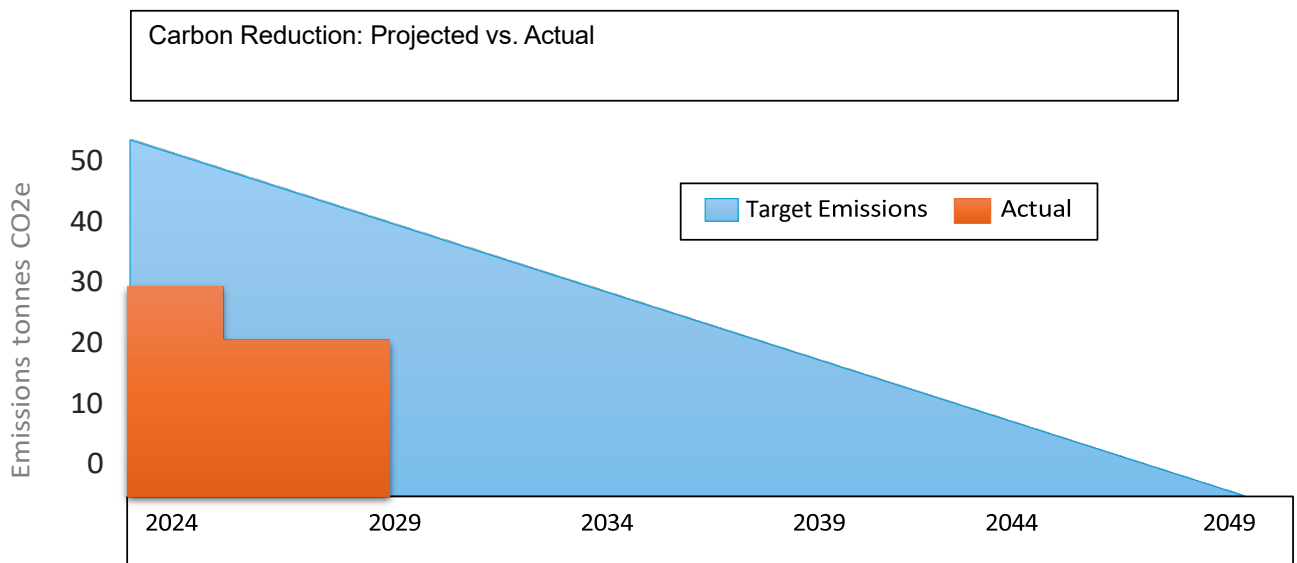

Emissions reduction targets

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 22.8 tCO₂e by 2029. This is a reduction of approximately 25%.

Carbon Reduction Targets

Carbon reduction initiative fully implemented in 2024 (baseline year). Environmental management measures and projects will be completed and implemented and measured against 2024. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes and the measures will be in effect when the 2025 report is published.

Scope 1 Planned Activities

Scope 1 OPP has an action plan to decrease emissions (natural gas and company vehicles) by 25% we will trial EV/Hybrid vehicles to reduce emissions for staff members who need to travel to work-related appointments. Encourage car share, where applicable, public transport to major events, if possible and promote hybrid meetings.

Scope 2 Planned Activities

Scope 2 reduction in electricity by 25% in FY25 against a FY24 baseline year. Activities attributed to emissions are due to the transition to a green electricity tariff across the UK operations. Installation of LED lighting across building areas is planned for 2024/2025.

Waste

OPP have set waste reduction targets across its operations which will result in the organisation recycling up to 30% of its waste. We are continuing to work with our service teams to increase recycling and reduce single-use plastic.

Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.


Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard⁴ and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting⁵.
